

# Sheriff's Report

February 02, 2018

Randolph County Sheriff Mark Nichols reports the following incidents, reports, investigations and arrests.

On January 24<sup>th</sup>, a deputy was dispatched to the 2100 block of Highway JJ in reference to assisting the Missouri State Highway Patrol with traffic control at the scene of a motor vehicle accident. The deputy remained on scene until the investigation was complete, vehicle removed and highway re-opened.

On January 25<sup>th</sup>, while conducting a stationary patrol on Highway JJ, a deputy observed a vehicle with a registration violation. The deputy initiated a traffic stop and identified the driver and passenger. The deputy learned that the license of the driver was revoked. The deputy then observed drug paraphernalia in the vehicle. The driver was arrested for driving while revoked and unlawful use of drug paraphernalia and the passenger was arrested for possession of a controlled substance. Both subjects were transported to the Randolph County Jail.

On January 26<sup>th</sup> at 9:56 am, a deputy received a theft report from a County Road 2505 resident. The complainant reported that he loaned a 2000 Chevrolet S-10 pickup to an individual. After several weeks, the individual who borrowed the vehicle refused to return the vehicle. The vehicle has been entered in MULES. The suspect has yet to be located for interview. The investigation continues.

On January 26<sup>th</sup> at 8:35 pm, a deputy responded to a residence in the 200 block of N. Main Street in Cairo in reference to a domestic disturbance. The complainant reported that she and her estranged husband became involved in a verbal argument. The husband departed the residence prior to the deputy contacting the complainant.

On January 27<sup>th</sup>, a deputy was dispatched to a business on County Road 1217 in reference to an assault. Upon arrival, the deputy met with the victim who had blood on his head. The complainant reported that he and another individual became involved in a physical altercation and the suspect struck the complainant in the head with an object. The name and possible location of the suspect was obtained. Officers responded to the location, finding that the suspect departed prior to their arrival. The report has been forwarded to the Randolph County Prosecuting Attorney for review and formal action.

On January 29<sup>th</sup> at 9:09 am, deputies responded to MRMC-ER in reference to an assault. Upon arrival the deputies learned that the victims had suffered stab wounds. The victims reported that one victim was involved in a verbal argument with his father when the father pulled a knife. The victim attempted to take the knife away and received a cut to his right hand. The second subject received a stab wound to the left side. Both subjects were treated and released. Deputies responded to the residence of the suspect and found him not to be there. The search for the suspect continues. The report has been forwarded to the Randolph County Prosecuting Attorney for review and formal action.

On January 29<sup>th</sup> at 6:17 pm, deputies were dispatched to a residence in the 1000 block of County Road 2360 in reference to a structure fire. Deputies provided traffic control until the fire was extinguished.

On January 30<sup>th</sup> at 8:50 am, a deputy was dispatched to a business on Highway 3 south in reference to an alarm sounding. Upon arrival, the deputy met with repairmen who were working on an electrical line. The repairmen advised the power outage caused the alarm to trigger.

On January 31<sup>st</sup> at 6:08 pm, deputies were dispatched to a location on Highway K in reference to assisting the Missouri State Highway Patrol with traffic control at the scene of a motor vehicle accident. The deputies remained on scene until the area was cleared.

On January 31<sup>st</sup> at 10:02 pm, a deputy was dispatched to a residence in the 2200 block of Highway JJ in reference to a chemical smell. Upon arrival, the deputy did not smell anything abnormal. No further action taken.

On January 25<sup>th</sup>, Christopher Alexander Messer, 19-years of age, from rural Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant for a probation violation for a class D felony charge of possession of a controlled substance except 35 grams or less of Marijuana/Synthetic Cannabinoid and a class A misdemeanor charge of leaving the scene of an accident. Bond set at \$10,000 cash only. Messer remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.

On January 26<sup>th</sup>, 19-year old, rural Moberly resident Rachel Ann Barton was served a Randolph County warrant for failure to appear on an ordinance violation of driver of motor vehicle failed to wear properly adjusted/fastened safety belt. Bond set at \$50 cash only. Barton posted the required bond and released.

On January 26<sup>th</sup>, 38-year old Springfield, Tennessee resident Joseph Aubrey Moon was served a Randolph County warrant for failure to appear on two class C felony charges of possession of controlled substance except 35 grams or less of Marijuana and a class A misdemeanor charge of

possession of up to 35 grams Marijuana. No bond was set. Moon remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.

On January 29<sup>th</sup>, 40-year old O'Fallon, Missouri resident Joseph D. Bias was served a Randolph County warrant for a probation violation on a class A misdemeanor charge of non-support. Bond set at \$1250 cash only. Bias remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.

On January 29<sup>th</sup>, 49-year old Moberly resident Cathy L. McCune a/k/a Cathy Louise Roe was served a Randolph County warrant for failure to appear on a class A misdemeanor charge of theft/stealing of property or services of less than \$500. Bond set at \$300 cash only. McCune posted the required bond and released.

On January 30<sup>th</sup>, 55-year old Carrie L. Kuhne a/k/a Carrie L. Mikel of Higbee was served a Randolph County warrant for failure to appear on a class D misdemeanor charge of stealing – value less than \$150 and no prior stealing offense and a class A misdemeanor charge of passing bad checks. Bond set at \$500 cash only. Kuhne posted the required bond and released.

On January 31<sup>st</sup>, 28-year old Columbia resident Richard Leroy Nole was served a Randolph County warrant for failure to appear on a class D felony charge of unlawful possession of a firearm and a class D felony charge of stealing – firearm/explosive weapon on/ammonium nitrate. Bond set at \$15,000 cash only. Nole remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.

On January 31<sup>st</sup>, 27-year old Salisbury resident Jacob S. Wilhelm was served a Randolph County warrant on the charges of possession of a controlled substance except 35 grams or less of Marijuana/Synthetic Cannabinoid and unlawful use of a weapon-exhibiting. Bond set at \$7,500 cash or surety. Wilhelm remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.

On January 31<sup>st</sup>, 27-year old Michael Eugene Sparkman of Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant for a probation violation on a class C felony charge of possession of a controlled substance except 35 grams or less of Marijuana. Bond set at \$25,000 cash or surety. Sparkman remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.

On January 31<sup>st</sup>, 27-year old Alexa Sky Ray of Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant for a probation violation on a class A misdemeanor charge of theft/stealing of property or services less than \$500, a class A misdemeanor charge of assault 3<sup>rd</sup> degree and an unclassified misdemeanor charge of driving while revoked/suspended – 1<sup>st</sup> offense. Bond set at \$500 cash only. Ray posted the required bond and released.

On January 31<sup>st</sup>, 46-year old Russell Wayne Kelso of Malta Bend was served a Randolph County warrant on a class D felony charge of possession of a controlled substance except 35 grams or less of Marijuana/Synthetic Cannabinoid. Bond set at \$7,500 cash or surety. Kelso remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.

On January 31<sup>st</sup>, 28-year old Andrea Renee Keefer of Moberly was served a Randolph County warrant on a class A felony charge of distribution of a controlled substance in a protected location, and two class C felony charges of delivery of a controlled substance except 35 grams or less of Marijuana/Synthetic Cannabinoid. Bond set at \$50,000 cash only. Keffer remains in the Randolph County Jail in lieu of the required bond.

On February 01<sup>st</sup>, 23-year old Clayton Scott Mckenzie of Jacksonville was served a Randolph County warrant for failure to appear on a class D misdemeanor charge of owner operated motor vehicle without maintaining financial responsibility – 1<sup>st</sup> offense. Bond set at \$150 cash only. McKenzie posted the required bond and released.

On February 01<sup>st</sup>, 29-year old Jacob S. Hendrix of Fayette was served a Randolph County warrant for failure to appear on a class B misdemeanor charge of exceeded the posted speed limit by 20 to 25 miles per hour. Bond set at \$300 cash only. Hendrix posted the required bond and released.
